

Granite Hills Baptist Church Sunday School Classes

Thank you for taking time to find a good Sunday School class. All classes meet at 9:30am at Granite Hills Baptist Church. For directions and more information, please visit ghbcreno.org. The pastors and leaders at Granite Hills strongly encourage all who attend to participate in a Sunday School class. In each class, there will be one or more teachers who weekly read the Bible, teach the Bible, lead discussions, and lead prayer for the class. Generally, you can expect to come into a room with a small group of friendly people who will welcome you and invite you to study God's Word with them.

Frequently Asked Questions:

- What curriculum do you use? At Granite Hills, we are currently using LifeWay's "The Gospel Project" curriculum for all Sunday School classes. This curriculum traces the main theme of Jesus and Redemption from Genesis to Revelation (all 66 books of the Bible). We have especially enjoyed studying the same passage each week through all age groups, encouraging families to discuss the Bible together. - Are your classes open to newcomers?
 Yes. All classes are welcoming to newcomers. Classes are divided generally by age-range, and visitors will likely feel most welcomed attending a class that corresponds well to their age and stage of life.
- What do I need to bring to class?
 First, an attitude ready to learn about God. Second, everyone should bring a Bible, and preferably a pen. Most classes will have either handouts or lesson books provided for free for participants.
- Is there any charge for Sunday School?
 No. Granite Hills Baptist Church believes Sunday School is one of the best ways to help Christians follow Jesus and we are pleased to offer classes for all ages free of charge. May Jesus be glorified!
- Why do you still call it Sunday School instead of small groups?

 It is true that our Sunday School classes seek to be small groups of believers gathered together.

 However, we do not want to give the impression that these groups promote relativism or

 "anything-goes" discussions. While many classes use discussions to facilitate learnings, each

 class is led by at least one biblically-qualified and trained teacher. Though some do not connote

 "school" with church, this is a misconception. At church we should enjoy learning about God by

 careful Bible study. While the preaching of God's Word maintains the central place of priority

 and worship at Granite Hills, we gladly encourage all members and visitors to participate in

 Sunday School.
